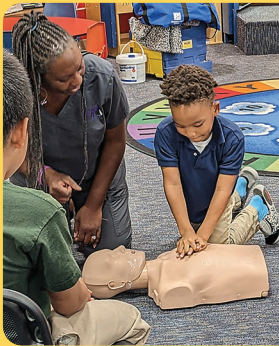




Let's Keep our Library Fully Funded
