What is 1000 Books Before Kindergarten?

Tangi Library is proud to participate in the national Early Literacy movement:

1000 Books Before Kindergarten!

The goal of this program is for Tangi parents and caregivers to embrace the importance of reading with the little ones in their lives and to encourage bonding through reading.

Why is this program important?

Experts agree that reading aloud to a child from birth is the single most important thing a parent or caregiver can do to prepare a child for reading and learning. Babies and toddlers grow in ways we can't always see! Reading aloud daily fosters brain growth and prepares kids for kindergarten.

Who can participate?

This program can be started at any time between birth and a child's 6th birthday. It is easy to register your classes as a single unit and log their books all at one time! You can do this after you read a certain number of books (50, 100...whatever you choose!) or at the end of every month. It is up to you! Repetition is good for growing minds. So don't be afraid to count that beloved title over and over.

How does the program work?

The program is simple! Sign up at <https://tangilibrary.beanstack.org> or in your favorite library branch to start logging books. 1000 books seems like a lot, but a single book read daily from a child's first birthday to their fourth birthday equals well over 1000 books! Three books read every day for a year is over 1000 books! When your class completes the program, Tangi Library will provide a certificate and a free book for you to use in your center as part of your existing awards day activities!
