These fun Bingo Bonanza Games will be held in the large meeting room of the library.

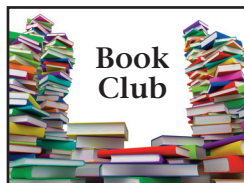


**INDEPENDENCE**
